

## **Role Title: Advisory Board Member with PR experience**

### **About the organisation**

The European Human Rights Advocacy Centre (EHRAC) is an independent legal centre based at Middlesex University within the School of Law. We work in partnership with NGOs and human rights lawyers in Russia, Georgia, Armenia, Ukraine and Azerbaijan jointly litigating at the European Court of Human Rights and other international fora to seek redress for victims of gross human rights violations and challenge impunity.

### **About the role**

EHRAC's Advisory Board is a UK-based advisory board that assist in the development of EHRAC as an organisation. It is composed of individuals who can offer guidance and advice in all our areas of work. Members of the Advisory Board are asked to:

- Commit to a two-year term;
- Be able to meet formally once a year in London;
- Attend other events when relevant and feasible;
- Offer interim advice at strategic level, not amounting to more than 15 hours per year (usually by phone or email);
- Act as ambassadors on behalf of EHRAC, attending its key events and networking on its behalf where feasible and appropriate.

Requirements for the position:

- At least 5-10 years of experience as a journalist, in a PR or communications role in the non-profit sector or a business;
- Have an extensive network of UK and international media and PR contacts-;
- Significant experience of developing and implementing international communications strategies;
- Experience developing and implementing social media campaigns;
- A strong interest in human rights and/or the former Soviet Union;
- Hands on approach and creative mindset.

EHRAC is based at Middlesex University (which has charitable status). It does not have separate legal or charitable status, and therefore members of the advisory board will not be trustees in the formal sense.

Advisory Board members are sought on a voluntary basis.
